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A Rare Cause of Rectal Bleeding due to Ingested Cow Bone

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Clinical Image

A 65 year-old man with rectal bleeding and severe pain in the anal canal admitted to emergency room. He had chewing problems for years because of dental loses. On physical examination, a foreign body with a sharp side embedded into anal canal was seen (Figure 1). Then we performed radiologic intervention. Abdominal direct imaging revealed approximately 4cm asymmetric opasity in the anorectal place (Figure 2). Foreign body was removed from the anal canal with sedation on gynecologic examination position (Figure 3).
